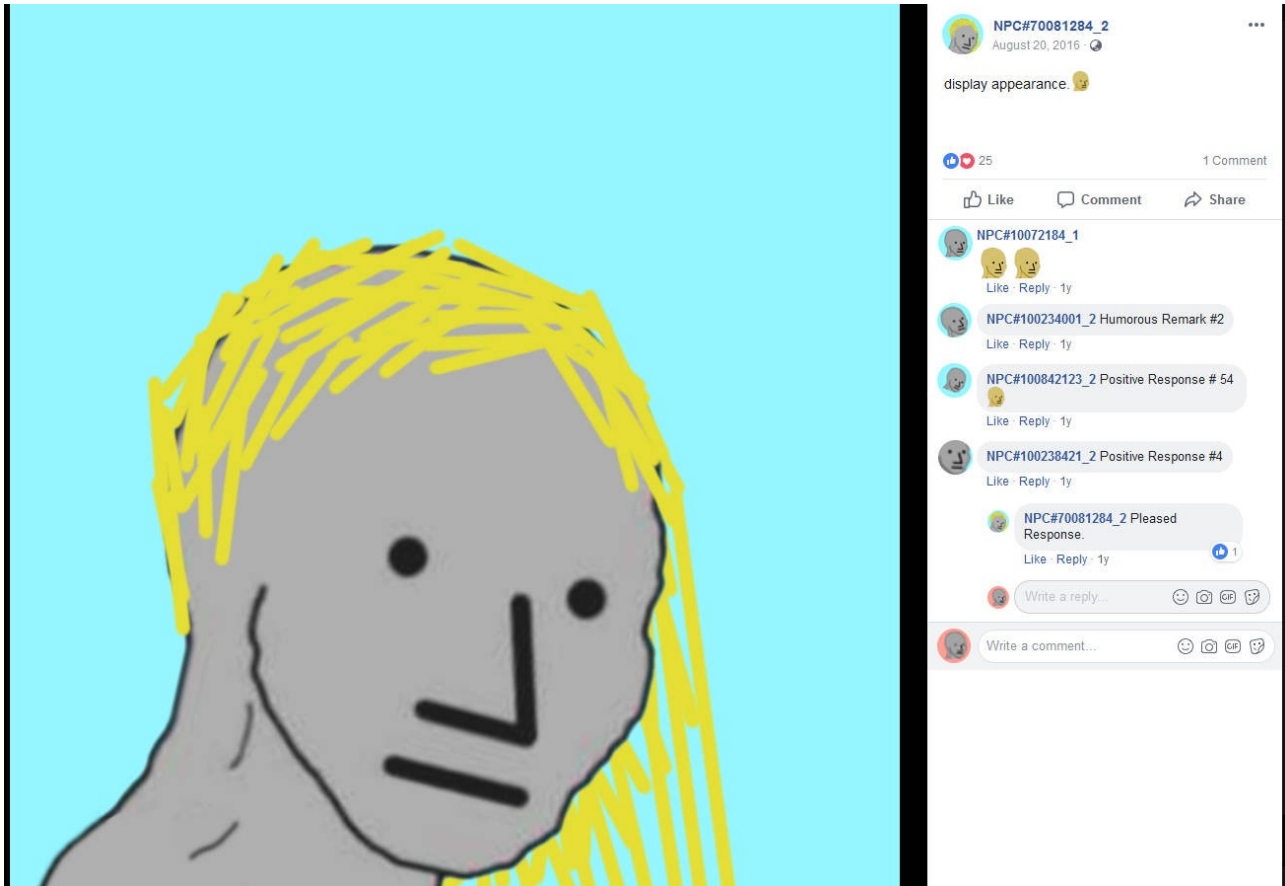


A Study Into Comment Sections of Teenage NPC's Projekt: Bestiana

I really can't be arsed going around every single account around the world. Sorry, I have a life.

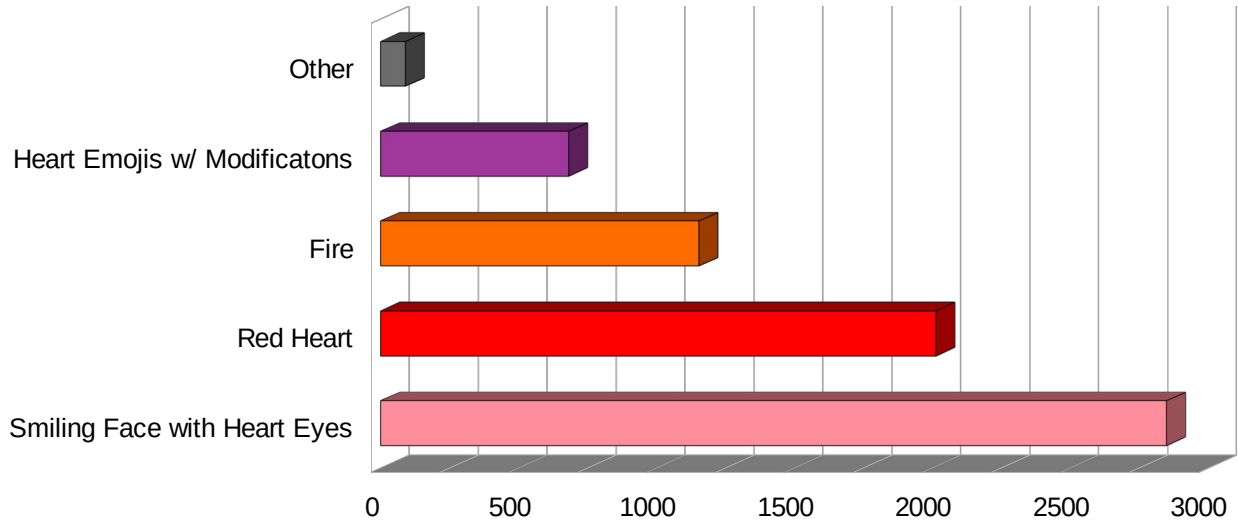
This research pool is data from at least **10** accounts from different friend/year groups on every single post starting from 2020. Now we can see the full cultural rot in swing with everyone being the same.

Emotions

In total shared there was over **6785** emotions. Of which, **2849** of them were “Smiling Face with Heart-Eyes” emoji that made up **42%** of all emojis posted. Second place being the “Red Heart” emoji appearing **2103** times making it 31%. The remaining few consisted of either modifications to the heart emoji such as “Arrow through heart”, “Beating heart” and lastly “Rotating hearts”. The fire emoji was also used often, but only on certain accounts racking up only 17% of all emojis used (**1153**).

20% Pretty

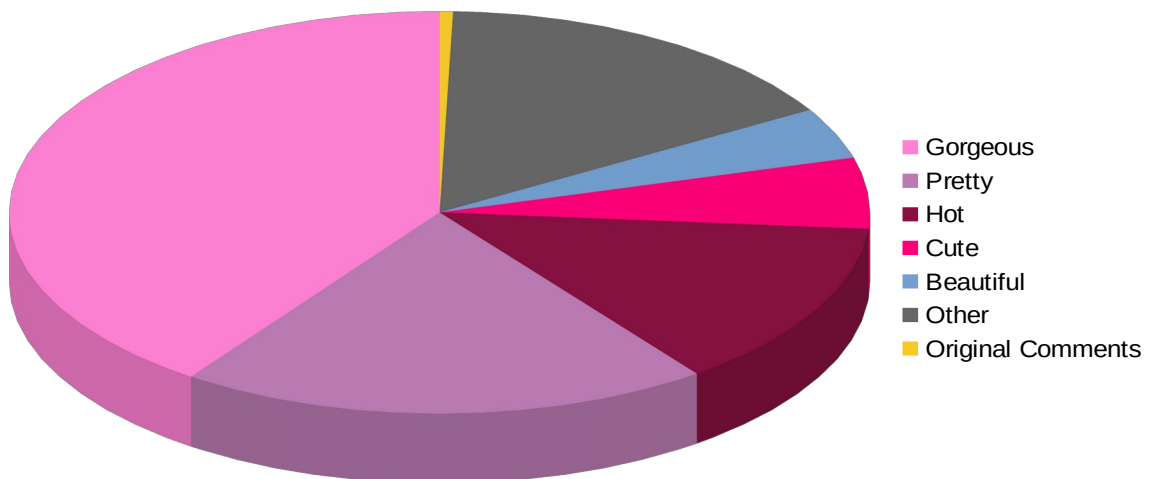
13.5% Hot

Average Follower Count

On average, all these accounts have **802** followers

Average Amount of Individual Accounts per comment Section

On average, one comment section has 24.5 individual accounts posting comments.

Average Amount of Comments Per Account in One Comment Section

On average, one account posts 2.34 comments per post comment section.

Average Amount of Likes per post

On average, there are exactly 80 likes per post.

Conclusion

Most of these comments and remarks are very cliché, monotonous and an never-ending wave of the same comment after another only difference being in account or variation of emoji. Despite a staggering amount of each comment section having around 25~ individual accounts posting comments, on average 42% of any comment will contain at least 1-2 “Smiling Face with Heart-Eyes” emoji attached with a “Gorg” that would appear at least in every 40.2% of comments.

This proves that these people NPC’s as they show signs of an NPC with repeating dialogue and not being able to think objectively. There is a lack of individuality in the case they just blend in with the NPC’s around them.

I wouldn’t say they’re retarded. They just lack dialogue.
